

**Hypochlorite (Bleach)
Solution Concentration**

	500 ppm (0.05%)	1,000 ppm (0.1%)	5,000 ppm (0.5%)
Bleach/water	1:100	1:50	1:10
Dilution of standard bleach (5.25%) in 1 gallon of water	2 ½ Tablespoons (1/6 cup)	5 Tablespoons (1/3 cup)	25 Tablespoons (1 2/3 cup)

Environmental surfaces that may be contaminated by norovirus should be disinfected using a chlorine bleach solution with a concentration of 1000-5000 ppm (5-25 tablespoons of household bleach [5.25%] per gallon of water) (CDC, 2011)
